Salin-de-Giraud & the Great Outdoors

Between the Rhône and the Mediterranean, explore one of the wildest sides of the delta.

- **Cycling, walking, or electric scooter rides:** discover exceptional wildlife amidst marshes and dunes.

- **Salt site visit:** wander through sparkling landscapes and watch the salt harvest.

- **Beaches:**

Piémanson – 7 km of fine sand, perfect for swimming and fishing.

Beauduc – legendary spot for kitesurfing enthusiasts and lovers of untamed nature.

- **Fishing and clam gathering:** immerse yourself in local maritime traditions.

- **Horseback riding at La Palissade:** ride between the sea and the Rhône delta (1 to 3 hours) with passionate guides.

- **Faraman Lighthouse:** enjoy breathtaking views of the marshes and ponds, just 10 km from the village.

- **Storytelling walks:** discover the working-class and architectural history of Salin-de-Giraud, blending memory and modernity.





Aigues-Mortes & the Salins du Midi

Immerse yourself in a landscape of rare beauty: the pink-hued salt flats, medieval ramparts, and sunlight reflecting off the canals.

Cycling or walking: over 20 km of marked trails through the salt pans, past salt tables, birds, and flamingos.

Panoramic tour by small train, car, or 4x4: explore spectacular landscapes and centuries-old expertise.

Aigues-Mortes ramparts & Constance Tower: step back into the history of knights while enjoying panoramic views of the marshes.

Canal cruise: glide along the Rhône-Sète canal aboard a barge or electric boat and savor the calm of the waterways.

Sand wine tasting: discover the unique terroir of vineyards such as Listel or Les Sables-de-Camargue.





Arles & Camargue Traditions

A city of art and history, Arles charms visitors with its heritage and Provençal atmosphere.

- **Visit the arenas**, Roman theater, and Saint-Trophime cloister: living testaments to the city's Roman past.
- In **Van Gogh's footsteps**: follow an artistic trail through the streets of Arles.
- **Horseback rides**: immerse yourself in the heart of the manades and Camargue landscapes (Mas Saint Germain, Salièrène, Palissade, Vigueirat).
- **Camargue Museum**: explore the history of the delta, where nature and traditions meet.
- **Pont-de-Gau Ornithological Park**: observe birds and flamingos along well-marked trails.
- **Crossing the Petit Rhône by ferry (Bac du Sauvage)**: a unique pause between the two banks, alongside the gardians.
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
